# • Called to Order by Jeff Parks

### • Previous Meeting Minutes

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed and approved, motion by Latham, seconded by Fisher

## • <u>Presentation by Robert Hallett and Andrew Hallett</u>

Robert Hallett and Andrew Hallett voiced concerns over the improvements to Skipton Landing. The concerns were whether the improvements would bring more users to the landing; therefore, possibly disrupting the tranquil setting and hurting his hunting contractor adjacent to the property. There were also concerns over the possible right of way, riparian rights and metes and bounds; these will be double checked with the County Attorney. Lastly, the request of possibly opening a kayak rental on their property near the landing was presented by the Hallett family.

### • <u>Chairperson Report/County Council Representative</u>

#### • Department of Parks and Recreation Report

- Landings Chapter 121: This will be presented to Council on 9/25/18 for vote.
- LiveBarn Update: Installation is scheduled and on time for the ice season.
- Bus Update: Has been taken to Jess Jr's and Sons in Cambridge for painting and modifications for state inspection. Will be white, will be looking into ideas for "decorating".

#### New Business

- **Budget:** FY2018 CC revenue was \$88,000 over anticipated.
- **Pools Update:** Revenue was down due to poor summer weather (rainy, cool) while swim lesson revenue was up; \$40,000, 1,300 lessons scheduled. Sink or Swim program has been instrumental in furthering the success of this program.
- **Summer Camp Update:** Expanded to 70 kids/week, revenue was \$86,506, increase of approximately \$24,000
- **Ice Rink Mechanical Update:** The ice plant equipment is aging, already over 15 years old, and will need replacing in the next years. I will be budgeting these in the capital items for FY20.
- Old Rag Mountain Hiking Trip Update: Worked with the CMRC to take 22 youth on a hiking trip to Shenandoah. Fun trip, saw a bear, got rained on, all looking forward to next adventure. Big THANK YOU to Dock Street Foundation for bus donation!
- **Jalopyrama Classic Car Show 2019:** New event in 2019, is renting the entire facility for a couple days, hopefully will be a returning event. These events are revenue generators since there is relatively no overhead on our part.
