Program Fees

It is the policy of the Talbot County Parks & Recreation Department that program participants help defray the direct costs related to an activity/program through the assessment of fees and charges. However, the department does not wish to exclude any child wishing to participate in any youth program regardless of financial ability. Persons who find themselves in need of assistance may contact the Community Center to inquire about our scholarship program.

Registration

We make the registration process easy by offering various ways to register for our programs! We offer online registration, registration by mail, registration by fax, registration by e-mail, or you can simply stop by to see us. If you choose to complete a registration form by fax or e-mail we will contact you for payment once we receive the registration form. Registration forms will be accepted Monday through Friday from 8am until 4:30pm. Registration is not complete until full payment is received.

Photo & Email Policy

On occasion, our staff may photograph participants in park programs or at special events. Please be aware that these photos are for our use only and may be used in future brochures, flyers, our web site or social media. By registering for any recreation programs, you agree to allow publication of any photos taken at any program, event or facility and occasional promotional emails regarding upcoming Talbot County Parks & Recreation programs.

Background Check Policy

As a community based organization we strive to create a safe environment for our volunteers, citizens and staff. Volunteer positions require successful completion of a criminal background check through Southeastern Security Consultants, Inc.

Refund Policy

The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel, postpone or combine programs due to low enrollment or unforeseen circumstances. If insufficient enrollment causes an activity to be canceled, participants will receive a full refund. If a participant drops out prior to the start of a program, a refund will be given. To request a refund, call or stop by the Community Center during business hours of 8:00am to 4:30pm Monday through Friday. A refund will not be given after the start of a program or to team entrants who drop out of a program after the schedule is completed.

Facility Rental Cancellation Policy

In the event that you need to cancel a facility rental, a one week notice is required to receive a refund. Call or stop by the Community Center during business hours of 8:00am to 4:30pm Monday through Friday.

Waiver Required

All participants are required to sign a waiver as Talbot County Parks & Recreation does not provide medical insurance coverage for persons participating in sponsored activities. By registering to participate in recreation programs, each applicant realizes the inherent risk of injury involved and understands the nature of these risks. The applicant agrees to hold Talbot County Parks & Recreation harmless for any injury caused by participation in these programs.

Inclement Weather

Talbot County Parks & Recreation reserves the right to cancel any program due to inclement weather. If at any time the Parks Department determines that any athletic field is not safe for participant use and/or cannot be used without creating damage or the potential for damage to the field or facility, the fields/facilities may not be used. The decision of Parks & Recreation personnel is final. We ask for your cooperation in caring for our fields and facilities in such a way as to safeguard the participants and preserve our facilities and fields for future and continued use. Parks and Recreation will make every effort to make such decisions in a timely manner but does reserve the right to make such decisions as needed even when advance notice is not possible.

Lost and Found

If you have lost or misplaced an item in one of the parks or program facilities, please contact the Talbot County Parks and Recreation Department office. Articles that are found and turned into the office are kept no longer than 14 days. After that period of time, the items are donated to a local charitable organization or more valuable items are taken to the Police Department. The Parks & Recreation Department is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Pets in the Parks

Unless posted, dogs, cats and other pets are permitted in county parks as long as they are kept on leashes or under similar restraints. Owners are responsible for the immediate cleanup, removal and disposal in a lawful manner of pet waste.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

A scholarship program is available for those who meet income guidelines, and is intended to assist those who cannot otherwise pay for program fees. Scholarship amounts are limited and are not available for all programs. For more information regarding scholarships, please call us or stop by the Talbot Parks & Recreation Office.

The Talbot County Community Center has numerous rental opportunities including meeting rooms, party rooms, and arena space for your group's next special event, meeting or reunion. All rooms require a completed rental agreement and full payment at time of reservation.

COMMUNITY ROOMS

Wye Oak Room

This room is 1,250 square feet and provides seating for 64 people with tables and up to 80 people without tables. Amenities included in this room are a projection screen and podium. Rate is \$60/hour.

Chesapeake Room

This room is 1,250 square feet and provides seating for 56 people with tables and up to 72 people without tables. Amenities included in this room are a projector and screen, bathrooms, and serving island. Catering Kitchen available for extra fee. The rate is \$60/hour.

Skipjack Room

This room is 750 square feet, seats 36 with tables and up to 50 without tables. The rate is \$40/hour.

Tuckahoe Room

This room is 575 square feet, seats 24 with tables and up to 36 without tables. The rate is \$40/hour.

Curling Rink

This room is 6,500 square feet, seats 200 with tables and up to 300 without tables. The rate is \$100/hour.
Available April–October.

Arena Rental

The arena is available for rent by the hour for your team's practice or for an all day tournament for hockey, figure skating, basketball, soccer, lacrosse or volleyball. The Arena is also a great place to hold a conference, banquet, or other special event.

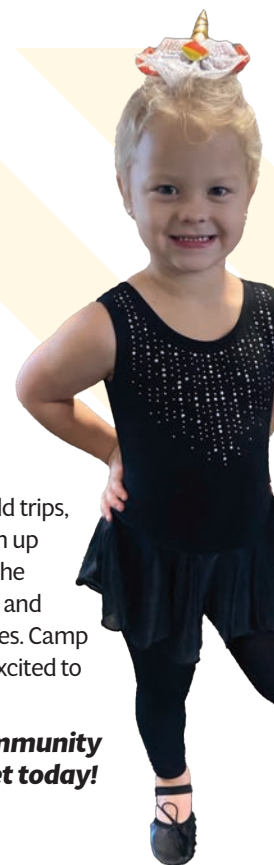

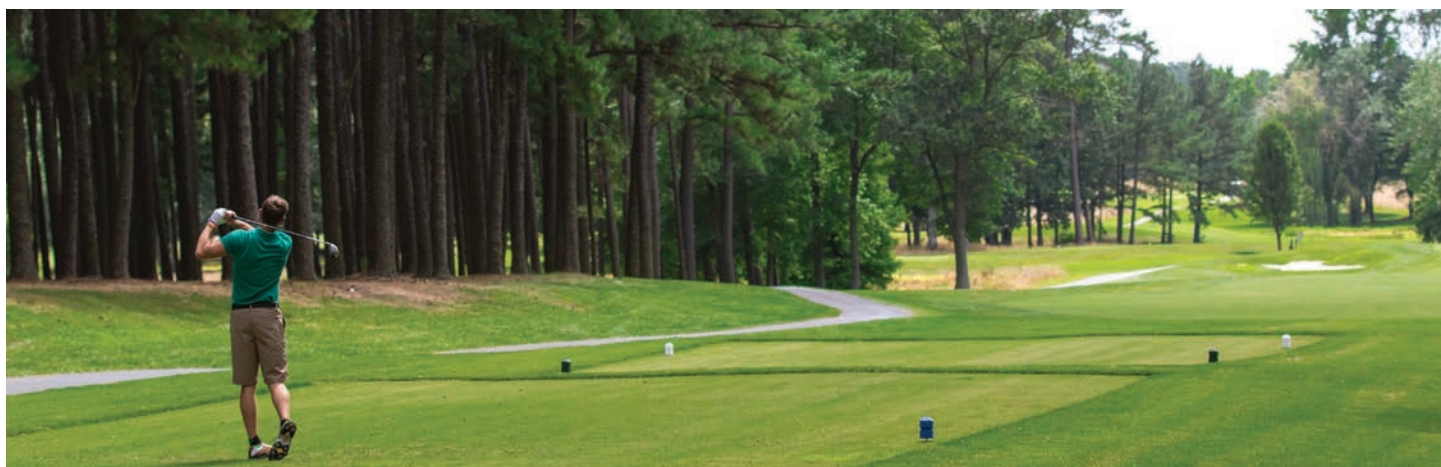

All landings are closed between the hours of 11:00pm and 4:00am unless you have an approved extended access permit. A valid landing permit must be acquired and displayed on your boat trailer or vehicle driver side rear bumper when using a Talbot County Public Landing/Ramp for launching or loading a vessel, or for parking a trailer at the facility. To obtain a permit please contact the Talbot County Parks & Recreation office at 410-770-8050.
